

SID: How could the Catholic Church make changes in the Jewish Bible? Both the Jewish and Catholic religions read the same Old Testament. How did the Catholics succeed in putting their changes into the Torah (the first five books of the Bible, that is most sacred to the Jews)?

AWAN: In the beginning of the Catholic religion, there were many men who did not have labor to go to, they were what you would term unemployed. It was very much like when your country was in a depression. There were many young men who were seeking work—they would do anything, to put some food in their stomach. The church created an army of these young men, with the high priest acting as general. The soldiers of this army later became known as the priests.

One army of priests was in charge of confiscating books. You must understand, the Catholic Church wanted total control over the people's lives. To accomplish their goal, the priests needed to rewrite history in such a way that it would agree with the system they were establishing. This is why they gathered all the books in every community of the Roman Empire. This is why they burned the great library of Alexandria in Egypt. They went out searching for books. They rewrote the books and reissued them. This even included the books and scrolls that formed the Bible.

These armies of Catholic priests marched into every village and hamlet, where Jewish people were living. They demanded that the Jews give them all of their books including their sacred Torah scrolls. If the Jews of a particular town handed over their scrolls, they received new scrolls, ones that were edited by the Catholic theologians. The old scriptures were taken out and burned. If the Jews of a different village did not cooperate and surrender their scrolls, the priests butchered everyone in the town. Then they proceeded to loot whatever possessions these people owned. Many treasures of these people are still in the hidden vaults within the Vatican today. It is very difficult for you to believe that a massive army that was created by this organization could go out and take over and control all the countries. They were swarming over every part of the land.

SID: Did the Bishop of Rome this organize this exchange of Bibles?

AWAN: Absolutely!! You have ancestors that had treasures taken from them that are still stored in the Vatican.

SID: Did this happen in the early 300's?

AWAN: Yes. It was during that time period.

SID: The Jews did not have any choice. Did they have to accept the scrolls that the priests gave back to them.

AWAN: That is correct.

SID: Were the scrolls that the priests gave back to them written in the Hebrew language?

AWAN: That is correct.

SID: Did that happen more than one time?

AWAN: Yes it did.

SID: So every time the Church wrote a new edition of the Bible, the priests confiscated the old ones?

AWAN: The men in black, the priests, would come in groups of three. In time, they were called soldiers of Christ. They would come on their horses, and knock on everybody's door and ask to see their Bible, and if the people did not have a Bible, the people were punished because they were not Christians. So the people would grab their Bible and bring it to the door and show it to these soldier-priests. Often these soldiers would take their Bible and give them a brand new Bible, one that church officials had edited, and tell them this new Bible replaces the old one. Most of them never bothered to open the new Bible to see if there were any changes made in them. After the priests searched the entire town, and exchanged all the Bibles, they would go to a secluded place outside the town. There they burned all the old Bibles in a big bon-fire. It was imperative for the priests to destroy all the evidence that contradicted the newly created false dogmas.

SID: And this happened for a few centuries.

AWAN: That is correct.

SID: Is this the reason that the oldest scroll of the Old Testament is 9th century A. D.? No older scrolls exist except for the Dead Sea Scrolls, which are locked away from the public.

AWAN: Absolutely.

SID: Do the Dead Sea Scrolls disagree with what is now printed in the Bible?

AWAN: If all the information from what you know as the Dead Sea Scrolls were released, all your religions, including Judaism, and Christianity, would collapse. Some of the Dead Sea Scrolls are the original, unedited text of the Bible. The priests did not get their hands on those ancient scrolls because they were hidden away for centuries. Reason it out, my scribe, why would the scrolls be hidden in caves? The Essenes were psychically gifted people—visionaries. They could see a time when priests would be rewriting history and rewriting the Bible. They wanted to preserve the original. Therefore they hid these scrolls. This is why the theologians of many religions have blocked the release of all the scrolls. The people on your planet have been misled—in the highest way possible by religions.
