A PSYCHIC DEMONSTRATION

A crowd of 200 people filled the Ball Room of the Sheraton Motor Inn, Norwich, to capacity, on March 20th 1976 at 8 P.M.

An accomplished pianist entertained the audience prior to the demonstration. A colorful sign of spring was a table covered with a yellow cloth, having a centerpiece of fresh flowers. This was reserved for the master of ceremonies, Mr. Harrington, and the two psychics — Miss Arlene Sikora, and Mr. Carl Hewitt.

Mr. Harrington opened the demonstration. He is a healer from Massachusetts and a man well-read on all facets of psychic work. Mr. Harrington defined psychic per the dictionary as meaning: lying outside of the sphere of physical science or knowledge, immaterial. Moral or spiritual in origin or force. "We are all psychics", he stated. "This is an inborn trait of man" and also, "psychic phenomenon are not supernatural but rather a

normal part of man". There are many kinds of psychic awareness", he continued. "such as clairvoyance, clairaudience, healing, telepathy, telekinesis, prophetic dreams, precognition, intuition, ghosts, seeing auras, feeling you have been someplace before, coincidences, psychometry and astral projections. He then introduced Miss Arlene Sikora, who gracefully glided into the ballroom and mounted the platform. Miss Sikora began to tell a brief story of her life. She was born in Buffalo, New York, is Polish, and has a Masters Degree from Florida State University. When she was 6 years old her grandfather died. That same night she saw him standing at the end of her bed. Her perplexed parents tried to talk her out of this vision, but to no avail. This vision continued for 2 years, as if her grandfather, from the other side of life, was trying to tell her

something. Finally Arlene was spanked by her parents and it was evident that her devout Roman Catholic parents never could or would understand. Arlene then closed the door to psychic awareness (temporarily). As is natural for Roman Catholic girls, Arlene considered becoming a nun, as she grew older. She got through college doing very little studying. She found she could anticipate tests and cram for them by memorization at the last minute. At age 21 she injured her back and spent 3 months in a hospital where the doctor told her she would not walk again. She prayed to the saints, the Blessed Mother, and Jesus. Soon afterward she saw a glow light and an image of Jesus, who seemed to be saying, "follow me". Arlene recovered and could again bowl, dance, and do all the nice activities she enjoyed so much. One day at home her mother showed her a

book about Jean Dixon, the famous Washington psychic and suggested she read it. Then Arlene began to read every book on psychic awareness and meditation, which she could find. One day she was meditating and praying over a lighted candle. She saw this candle move up and down and side to side. It burned the sign of the cross on a table which Arlene still owns and uses. Arlene has learned to use her gift in her line of professional work. She has 360 young people to counsel in the field of educational and vocational guidance. In public Arlene has given as many as 88 psychic readings in a single evening. She then gave the audience 9 psychic predictions for the future. Following an ovation she sat down and sipped from a glass of water.

Mr. Harrington then introduced Mr. Carl Hewitt, often called the "Salem Psychic". He is

a businessman who has lectured in the East and on the radio, and appeared on television. Carl strode into the ballroom and mounted the podium. In very resonant tones he began to describe his childhood in North Carolina. Carl's father owned a farm and raised Ford Hook Lima Beans. Due to the distance from the farmhouse to the fields, Carl's mother took lunch daily to his father. One day Carl, age 3, began to cry and said to his mother, "Annie is dead". (Annie was Carl's half-sister.) His mother's response was to give Carl a spanking. A short time later his 14 year old brother reported that indeed Annie was dead of consumption. At ages 4, 5, and 6, Carl began predicting the future, and heard voices. Both his parents thought he was crazy. So Carl kept to himself and became a "loner". His father, a strict Baptist, read the Bible from cover to cover. Carl stated that all the gifts mentioned by Mr. Harrington, Miss Sikora, and himself can be found written in the Bible—both old and New Testaments. A better understanding of this work can be found by reading "The Living Bible" — a modern English translation. This can be found in most bookstores. Carl suggested we all read Samuel I, Chapter 9. Carl could not accept the strict teachings of the Baptists and left home at age 16. He travelled alot, trying to run away from himself. He thought his psychic gift was a curse, not a blessing. At age 23 in Connecticut, he encountered a psychic. This person pointed him out in a

crowd and told him his past, present, and future. He was tremendously happy and relieved. He was told, "one of these days you will be on stage". Twenty one years later everything this woman psychic said has come true.

Carl went on to explain that a medium, a psychic, a seer, and a prophet are all one in the same. In April of 1975 Carl's personal physician found out after 14 years that Carl was a "psychic". The physician then said "why didn't you tell me this a long time ago?" This same physician travels regularly to Africa to study tropical diseases. He stated that all African doctors are seers, prophets, and mediums. This physician is a man of high intellect, who has come to accept the "psychic world". Carl then gave 8 predictions for the future, including a look into the stock market.

The obvious question which comes to our minds is how can we develop our psychic awareness if we so desire. Miss Sikora holds classes in Springfield, Massachusetts. She suggests we read a book entitled "Man Know Thyself". Carl Hewitt is also holding classes. For more information, you may phone him at Oakdale 443-3201. A question and answer period was next. What is God? Who is God? Answer — God is a universal force, a part of everything. We are all God's in embryo. We are all a part of this force of love. All denominations are good and all religion is good as long as people learn and grow from it. Both Arlene and Carl agreed — "We would not condemn any religious denomination."

After a 5 minute intermission both Arlene and Carl gave personal readings to members of the audience. These were most enlightening.

As soon as plans can be worked out, Arlene Sikora and Carl Hewitt will be sponsored by an international hotel chain to travel throughout the country to give still more such psychic demonstrations.
