

New association plans 'A Time to Heal'

HARTFORD — A new group, the American Spiritual Healing Association, will sponsor a special program from 2 to 6 p.m. Sunday at The Meeting House at 50 Bloomfield Ave., Hartford.

The Rev. Carl R. Hewitt of Oakdale is first vice president of the association which, he said, has been established "to bring credibility to spiritual healing through documentation and cooperative interaction with religious and medical professionals."

The program Sunday, titled "A Time to Heal," will feature Olga Worrall. The Rev. Mr. Hewitt describes her as an internationally known spiritual healer, author and lecturer.

The associate director of the New Life Clinic in Baltimore, Md., she has lectured to scientific groups in this country and abroad and has cooperated with para-psychologists in work about "the healing energy."

Also speaking will be Dr. Shirley Winston, a licensed psychologist who also works as a psychic healer,

and the Rev. Dr. Charles Havens, an ordained Episcopal priest, consultant to the Pastoral Counseling Center of Greater Providence and director of a private psychotherapy practice in Shrewsbury, Mass.

The Rev. Mr. Hewitt said the Sunday program will be the second presentation sponsored by the new association. The first was conducted last week in Boston.

The association says its purposes also focus on the accreditation of spiritual healers, publication of a directory of healer's names, public programs, training and issuing of special reports.
