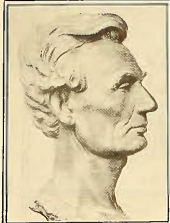

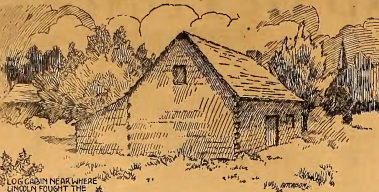

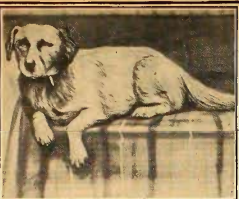

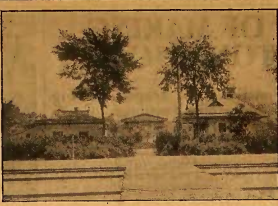

UNDAUNTED in his boldness and courage in the face of adversity, Lincoln was born in a log cabin in Kentucky, and his early life was spent in the most primitive conditions. His father, Thomas Lincoln, was a poor farmer, and his mother, Nancy Hanks, was a simple, virtuous woman. Lincoln's early education was limited, but his natural genius and determination allowed him to overcome these obstacles. 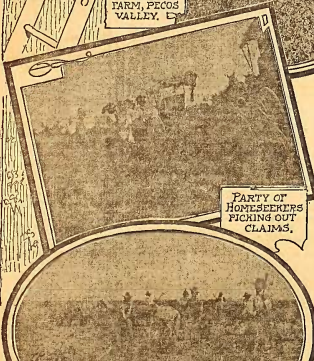

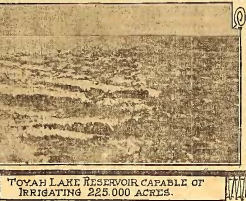
